Relax, take some time off and we will see you at the races on July 12th or at Texas A&M at the Regional Conference.

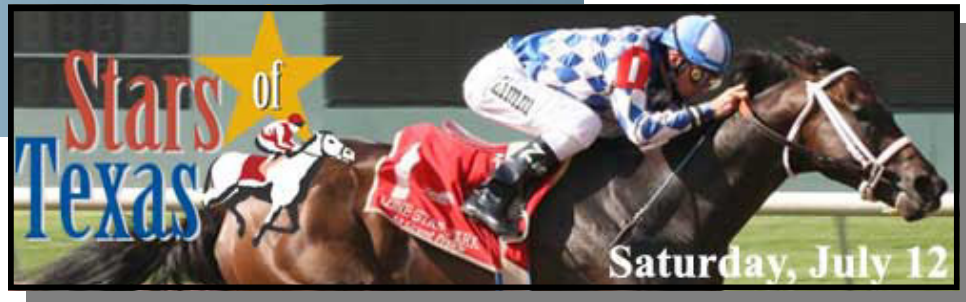
The next regular chapter meeting is September 9, 2008.
