The following items should be submitted: (20 Points)

1. Completed and signed application.
2. Official transcript of ALL studies taken beyond high school level.
3. Official high school transcript if you have not completed at least one full year of study beyond the high school level.
4. A letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor or guidance counselor.
5. A letter of recommendation from an employer or professional associate. If you have not had significant professional employment, the letter may be from a community leader or clergyman with whom you are personally acquainted but not related.
6. Provide a current photo and brief bio of yourself.
7. Essay with a minimum of 250 words and a maximum of 500 words.

This original application, transcripts of all college level work, and high school work if the applicant has not completed one full year of college, and two letters of recommendation, essay, along with photo and bio must be submitted to Donna Harrison, Chapter 36 Scholarship Committee Chair, no later than **April 14, 2012** as verified by the postmark or email delivery date. Electronic copies in .pdf format are acceptable provided a signed application is attached. Applications and supporting material will not be returned.
